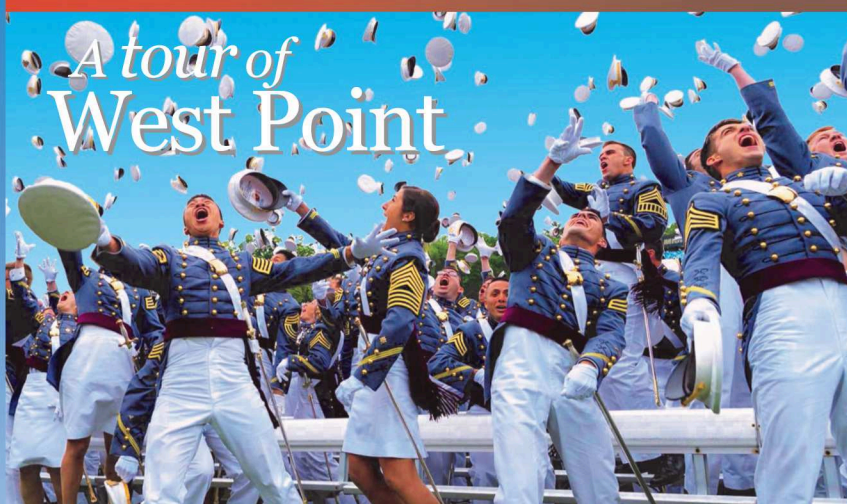

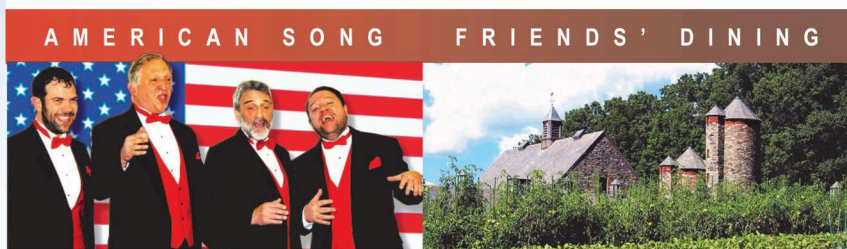


The U. S. Military Academy at West Point

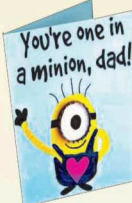

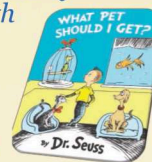
